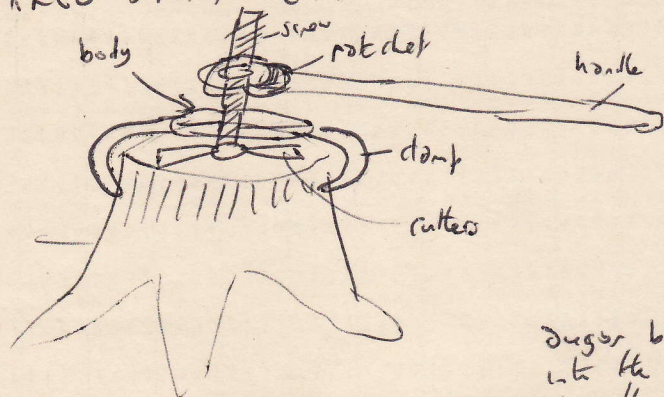


TREE STUMP EXTRACTOR

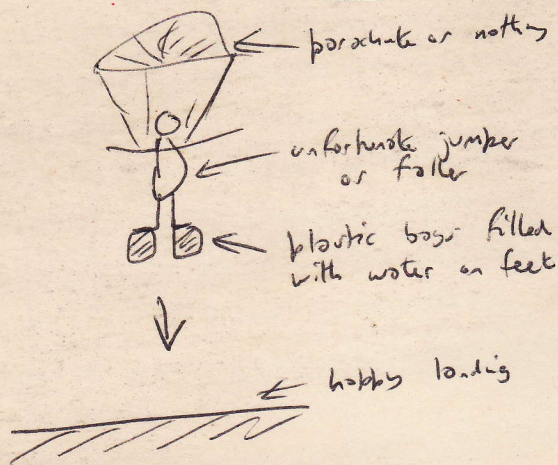
Aim in stump extraction is to get the substance out. This idea is to remove most of the substance of the stump out with an auger arrangement on a long handle with ratchet. The body of the cutter is clamped onto the sides of the stump,

auger blades are put in and screwed down into the stump, chewing a cylinder as they go, when the device depth is needed, the operation

is repeated with a wider cut until only a thin shell is left which can be pulled in. Long handle for good leverage - essentially a manual method using a easily transportable tool - aimed at garden maintenance market.
