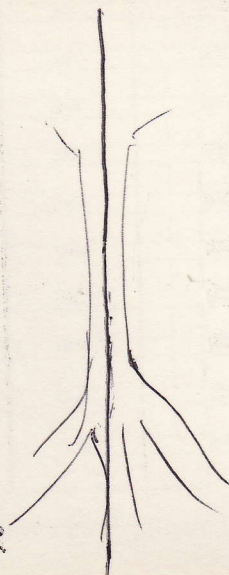

ROOT-STEM INTERFACE

In most woody plants, a distinctive change occurs at the crown of the plant where root tissue and stem tissue meet.

There must be possible propagation methods (e.g. splitting the plant down lengthways) which allow preservation of both ~~parts~~ ^{parts} of tissue and do not require root ~~removal~~ ^{removal} on stems or vice versa.
